Update from President (Jen Tedrow)

- Sponsorships with Raising Canes and John Greene Realtor are requesting a table at the football game on 10/18
- NV Boosters will provide two 6 feet tables for sponsors to use
- NV Boosters is still looking for sponsors
- Athletico is contracted through the district office and their contract will be expiring this year
- Consider setting up a Booster membership table at P/T conferences in November

Athletic Director (Branden Adkins)

- Early November is when winter sports will kick off
- 12/7 wrestling invite
- 12/14 JV quad wrestling in the Aux gym
- 12/14 girls basketball JV and Varsity will be playing
- 1/21 NV will host the Conference Cheer invite at 5:30pm
- Swim parents run their concessions

Sponsorship (Heidi Hairston)

• No update

Treasurer (Elizabeth Sigal)

- Wildcat Wear and concession books are closed for September
- Concessions showed higher profitability with the most recent deposit; profit gains depend on the payment cycle
- The bank has a money counter to verify our amounts for accuracy
- Go Fund balance is up due to increased ticket sales

Membership (Becky Barkley)

- 229 total members: 126 Wildcat Club members and 33 Booster members
- Membership numbers are lower than previous years
- Explore restructuring membership and offering better incentives for joining
- Meet with MV and WV to brainstorm strategies for increasing membership
- Pre-package swag bags for new sign-ups; this could be a great idea for 8th Grade Night in January

Concessions (Huma Khimani)

- Last outdoor concession will be held on 10/18
- Concessions have been running out of cash for change (need singles); considering starting with a larger bank during football season
- Indoor concession will need volunteers, dates coming soon
- Inspection for outdoor concessions 10/16
- Shoutout to Heather and Jen T for all their help with concessions
- Discuss offering different options for next season and increase prices
- Need help shutting down concessions for the season and moving drinks & food to indoor concessions for the winter.

Wildcat Wear (Krista Leifheit & Colleen Garrison)

- Plan to offer coffee and donuts on a Thursday or Friday during the first week of December
- Host an evening event in early December for families to shop for the holidays
- Explore the process for offering gift certificates for purchase
- Online store: Class shirts are sold through an online store managed by our vendor; NV Boosters will receive a percentage of sales and plans to purchase some inventory to keep on hand
- Holiday sweatshirts are currently in stock.

Fundraising (Jen Lewand & Heather Stupay)

- Raised a total of \$443 from the Split the Pot fundraiser
- Include advertisements for our sponsors on the website
- Dick's Sporting Goods: Can we secure an NV-exclusive 20% off promotion, with NV Boosters receiving 20% back?
- Consider hosting an AMC movie night where NV Boosters receive a portion of the proceeds
- Scent Hound: \$39 service in November, with NV Boosters receiving \$10 from each service booked
- Ornaments: Sell for \$20 each, with 20% of the profit going back to NV Boosters.
- Determine the deadline for ornament orders
